**Yard Waste Only:**  
Mondays: 7am–6pm

### Solid Waste and Small Quantities of Yard Waste:

Tuesday-Friday: 7am-6pm  
Saturdays: 8am-3pm

### Fees at Transfer Station:

-\$ .75/bag for Yard Waste & Solid Waste or  
-\$65/ton [\$.0325lb.] Solid waste  
-\$65/ton [\$.0325lb.] Demolition material.  
(Minimum \$7 per demolition load)

-Uncontaminated oil and oil filters  
accepted at no charge

*You must give a complete listing of items you wish to have picked up to the office and placed curbside no later than 7am on your appointed pick up day. OR*

Along with their curbside recycling program [see [schedule](#)], Waterloo Waste Management offers a service to its residents for bulk items:

#### Placing an Order:

To have your items picked up call [319]-291-4553 between 7am and 5pm [Monday-Friday].

#### What's Accepted?

Waterloo Waste Management's bulk item program accepts most bulk items at a rate of 10 items for 10 dollars. Items include furniture, mattresses, box springs, and other items.

#### Some items have special fees:

⇒ Refrigerators-\$12

⇒ Washers/Dryers-\$4

⇒ 4 tires [per resident]-\$3

These items count towards the 10 total items per pickup.

#### Bags of Items:

[such as after cleaning closets, etc.] are accepted as well. 2 Bags count as one item. Bags of items should not have any food or other regular trash.

## WAVERLY RECYCLING CENTER

412 1st Ave. In Waverly [319-352-3173] or [319-352-6247]

The city of Waverly utilizes curbside recycling for tin, plastics, cardboard, clear glass, newspaper, and magazines.

### Hours of Operation

7 am-5:30pm Monday - Friday  
8am-noon Saturday  
(unless on a holiday)

Additional items such as colored glass, motor oil, aluminum, and styrofoam peanuts can be taken to 412 1st Ave.

### Recycling Compact Fluorescent Light Bulbs

## CITY OF INDEPENDENCE RECYCLING

## HUDSON RECYCLING

Hudson residents may drop off recyclables at the Hudson drop site on Dale St. Downtown.

Yard waste pickup is free to Hudson residents who pay for trash pick-up. Branches must be bundled and debris must be put in lawn waste bags. Pickup is every Friday from April through November
